Meeting Minutes

March 13, 2014

Meeting was called to order by Christie Barber at 12:05 p.m. She welcomed all the guests to the meeting and thanked Katie Seabold for the center pieces. Christie said the flowers at each table may go home with those sitting at that table. This was followed by the introduction of all guests.

President Kathy Johnston mentioned the upcoming art events information table and several members gave short reports on upcoming events. Joya Granbery-Hoyt talked about two donations given to Outside the Box, to go to the middle school thru the generosity of the guild members. The donation to the 8th grade class was for fabric and supplies for a sewing class where they will make pants, taught by Karen Bobren, and the donation to the 6th and 7th grade classes will be used to fund a field trip to the Palm Springs Art Museum, including dinner out. Ginger Dunlap-Dietz talked about an upcoming show at the Borrego Art Institute, Celebrating Clay & Glass. Ginger said there would be artists from San Diego, Pomona, and Laguna Beach. To kick off the event there will be a 2 day workshop and a 1 day workshop given by San Diego potter, Richard Burkett. Kathy Johnston reminded all of the Circle of Art on March 15th and 16th. She also acknowledged Sally Williams and the successful Art Guild show at the BAI. Finally, Kathy asked for a show of hands of those who would be interested in attending a tour of the BAI After School Art Program at the elementary school after next month's meeting, April 10th. She counted the hands and said she would let everyone know prior to next month's meeting.

Secretary Report: Kathy Johnston stated that the minutes were sent to the membership with the newsletter. She asked if there were additions or corrections. None were given. Minutes were approved as published.

Treasurer's Report: Beth Hart gave the treasurer's report. She stated that we have \$784 in checking and \$9,200 in savings. Because of the generous support of the raffle from last month, the Guild was able to send \$100 each to the elementary and middle school/high school art programs. She asked if there were additions or corrections to the treasurer's report. None were given. Treasurer's report was approved as read.

Membership and Roster: Anne Wermers stated that the 2014 membership rosters were ready to be picked up. She reminded us that we could still pick up our rosters after the meeting and it was not too late to pay dues and be a member for the 2014 year.

Circle of Art: Beth Hart reported that 8 guild members will be displaying their art in the guild's both at the Circle of Art, March 15th and 16th. She encouraged all to stop by the booth to view their work.

The members and visitors of the Guild were treated to a preview of the play, "Nunsense". Lunch was served. The raffle, including tickets donated by Ron Regalado, was held during the lunch.

Christie Barber introduced the speaker, Ron Regalado, who spoke about working for Disney Studios as a creative director, as well as talking about his own passion, Surf Culture Photography.

Meeting was adjourned by Kathy Johnston at 1:45 p.m. She announced that Kay Levie will be the speaker for April.
